Resolution of Differences Covenant

2018 -19 Academic Year



- Veritas Classical Academy exists to assist parents in the bringing up of their children in the instruction and admonition of the Lord (Eph 6:4). We, as parents, understand that we are ultimately responsible for the education of our children. We will strive to disciple our children at home spiritually, mentally, morally, socially and physically. We believe that as a child grows in obedience to God and applies himself to the educational process, he will increase in favor with God and mankind. (Luke 2:52)
- In order to fulfill the above goals effectively, we understand that we are delegating part of that parental authority to Veritas school and the teachers (*in loco parentis*). This entails that we agree and follow the Veritas' educational vision and goals, which are founded upon God's Word, and to give full authority to the school and the teachers regarding instruction, curriculum design, grading, and classroom management.

We understand that the role of the parents, on the academic level, is to completely support the policies of the school and the authority of the teacher, and to guide our children in completing their homework. Parents in the primary level (1-6th grades) are expected to train their children to have a good study habit, and to provide some help in completing their homework such as reading and editing. Parents in the secondary level (7-12th grades) are expected to train their children to have a good study habit and to guide them through discussion based on their homework.

- Attending or serving at Veritas Classical Academy is a privilege and not a right. Courteous behavior, respect for authority, and consideration for others is expected from each staff member, student, and parent. (Romans 12:9, 10) The Parent/Student Handbook clearly and more completely expresses our Biblical perspective on values, responsibilities, and procedures.
- Although there may be minor differences in understanding, all staff, parents, and students at Veritas Classical Academy agree to voluntarily submit to the standards set forth in the Parent/Student Handbook for conduct. (1 Peter 2:13-15) If a problem arises, the parent should contact the teacher/staff member first (or vice-versa) and try to resolve the problem. If this fails, then the individual should contact the Principal. If the problem is not resolved, then the individual should contact the School Board for final disposition of the matter, pending its formation (Matthew 18:15-17).
- By signing this covenant, we the parents are committing to pay our financial obligation to Veritas Classical Academy. If we do not pay on or before the due date, we accept the \$30 late charge per month. We also understand the school policy that our child can be removed from class if we become delinquent on our account.

We promise to support the teachers, staff, and administration by word and deed, and to encourage obedience to the standards of the school as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook, and understand the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not respect its spiritual, moral, or ethical standards or

cooperate in the educational process. We understand that if applicable, assessments will be made to cover damage to school property (window breakage, abuse of books, etc.)

- I/We promise to give our cooperation in faithful prayer, recommended practical help, and homework.
- The parties to this covenant are Christians and believe that the Bible commands them to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian community in conformity with the Biblical injunctions of I Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23-24, and Matthew 18:15-20. Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute arising out of, or related to, this covenant or to any aspect of the school relationship, including statutory claims, shall be settled by Biblically-based mediation and, if necessary, legally binding arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation of the Institute for Christian Conciliation, a division of Peacemaker Ministries (406 256-1583 or www.HisPeace.org). Judgment upon an arbitration decision may be entered in any court otherwise having jurisdiction.
- Neither party shall institute litigation or any Court proceedings as to any matter that can be properly submitted to Biblically based mediation. All parties understand that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of this relationship and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit in any civil court against one another for such disputes, except to enforce an arbitration decision. The California Arbitration Code shall not apply to any arbitration or award under these rules.
- I/We understand the school is not a corrective institution and will not enroll our child with the idea that the school will reform him/her.
- I/We understand the administration has full responsibility for placing our child in the proper grade.
- If I/we become dissatisfied with Veritas Classical Academy in any respect, we will seek to resolve the matter with the persons involved. We also agree that, if our child should become involved in an undesirable situation, we will refrain from complaining to other parents, but in the love of Christ and with prayer we will register only the necessary complaints with the teacher and/or administration of the school.
- I/We promise to support the teachers, staff, and administration by word and deed, and to encourage obedience to the standards of the school as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook, and understand the school reserves the right to dismiss any student or family who does not respect its spiritual, moral, or ethical standards or cooperate in the educational process.
- I/We promise to give our cooperation in: a) faithful prayer, b) parent participation, c) work at home, and d) discipline.
