We recommend TI-84 calculators to those who will be continuing onto Pre-Calculus and AP Calculus courses. Due to high costs of these calculators (You may find used ones for cheaper price on eBay), those students who will be taking up to Algebra 2 may purchase a cheaper graphing calculator. All others need just basic scientific calculators that has basic trigonometry function keys such as sin, cos, tan, and also log functions.
